- 1. The book of Job hovers around the theme of suffering, which can drive us to ask questions. What questions do you have right now for God?
- 2. Suffering challenges us to say, "do I believe what I say I believe?" How have you experienced this?
- 3. Kevin explained how our vision of God shapes what kind of questions we ask him. What's your vision of God?
- 4. The passage introduced us to Job's friends who sat with him and created space for him to lament. Who has done this for you, and who in your life can you do this for?
- 5. Another theme in Job is God's wisdom. Do you trust the supreme and unparalleled wisdom of God?
- 6. Kevin shared how we can't follow Jesus without repentance. What would it look like to set a consistent rhythm of repentance in your own life?
- 7. The main idea of the message was, "God is not about retribution, but about redemption." How can you remind yourself that God is loving, not punitive?
