- 5. Dan shared the prominent verse Job 19:25; "I know that my redeemer lives." How have you experienced Christ as your personal Redeemer?
- 6. A main truth from the sermon was, "In the middle of suffering, we need to trust God; He has a vantage point." In what area of your life can you apply this and how may this group pray for you in this?
- 7. Who in your life could take comfort in this section of Job, and be refreshed that God's justice isn't delayed?
