3. a) From **Hebrews 3:1**, describe the people to whom this letter was written and what the author invites them to do.

b) What similarity between Jesus and Moses is found in **V2**?

4.	From V3-4 , explain in your own words why Jesus was "worthy of greater honor than Moses"?
5.	a) Compare and contrast Moses and Jesus according to V5-6 .
	b) V5-6 refers to "God's house." Who comprises this house and what are its essential characteristics? For more insight read Ephesians 2:19-22 .
6.	Read Numbers 12:1-9 . What did the LORD have to say about Moses?
7.	What more do you discover about Moses and His role as deliverer from the following verses: • Exodus 3:7-12

10. CONSIDER JESUS: THE BETTER DELIVERER

To the Jewish mind, no one stood closer to God than Moses. He was the man who spoke to God face to face; he received the Law and wrote it down. He was chosen by God to deliver His people from slavery in Egypt. And yet Jesus is the better deliverer. Meditate on how Jesus was God in flesh, who satisfied all the requirements of the Law and delivered you from slavery to sin. Spend some time asking the One who is worthy of greater honor than Moses for delivery from something or someone who may still have a grip on you.
