

WOMEN OF THE NEW TESTAMENT SHARING CLASS LESSON

LESSON 27

Sharing Class at WBS is a time to look back and celebrate what we've learned throughout the year. This lesson is designed to help you in your time of reflection. You might want to use your "Weekly Nugget" sheet as you answer these questions.

1. Many lessons have been learned from these well known and lesser known women of the New Testament. Each has left a legacy...some "Good," some "Bad," and some downright "Ugly."
 - a) Pick your favorite woman that demonstrated the "Good." What did you admire most that you want God to build in you?
 - b) Pick the woman who most exemplified the "Bad and Ugly" and share why her life was a warning or perhaps was convicting for you.
2. Time and time again we saw women in the New Testament who were transformed by the Gospel or by their personal encounter with Jesus. What changes have you experienced this year in your encounter with Jesus?

3. From the beginning of this study when Mary said, “I am the Lord’s servant” (**Luke 1:38**), to the end where Paul acknowledged so many women who served the Lord (**Romans 16**), we also are given a clear call to serve. How have their examples encouraged or challenged you in serving Him?
4. Which verse **from this year’s study** is your favorite and why?
5. As we looked at the “sunset” of each life from the women we studied in the New Testament, we were coached with “sunrise” thinking for our own lives. Each time you see a sunrise or sunset, which one truth **from this year’s study** will you cling to?
